It's a free service and could save you several thousands of dollars in fines. We personally have had the customer making the call for us, but that is not legal.

Allen Hof & Matt Sundeen presented us with a very upbeat and fast moving seminar entitled Jobsite Safety and Risk Management. Through the seminar they bounced back and forth giving us information on safety from loading equipment in the yard, transporting to the jobsite and actual work to be done. Allen's hands on experience and Matt's insurance reports of job hazards remained engaging throughout the presentation. Matt also gave us some good pointers on documentation all throughout the course of the job. He also supplied some suggestions to educate possible customers in what a qualified mover should be able to present to the customer: Insurance, list of past customers, ect.



I felt all of these presentations should have been recorded; I would have loved to share this information with my crew first hand. The key point I took away from this seminar was having good communication with your workers. Being able to explain what the job entails and working on the jobsite safely; exploiting the potential safety hazards: ice, oil spills, electrical or gas lines, to name a few.
