

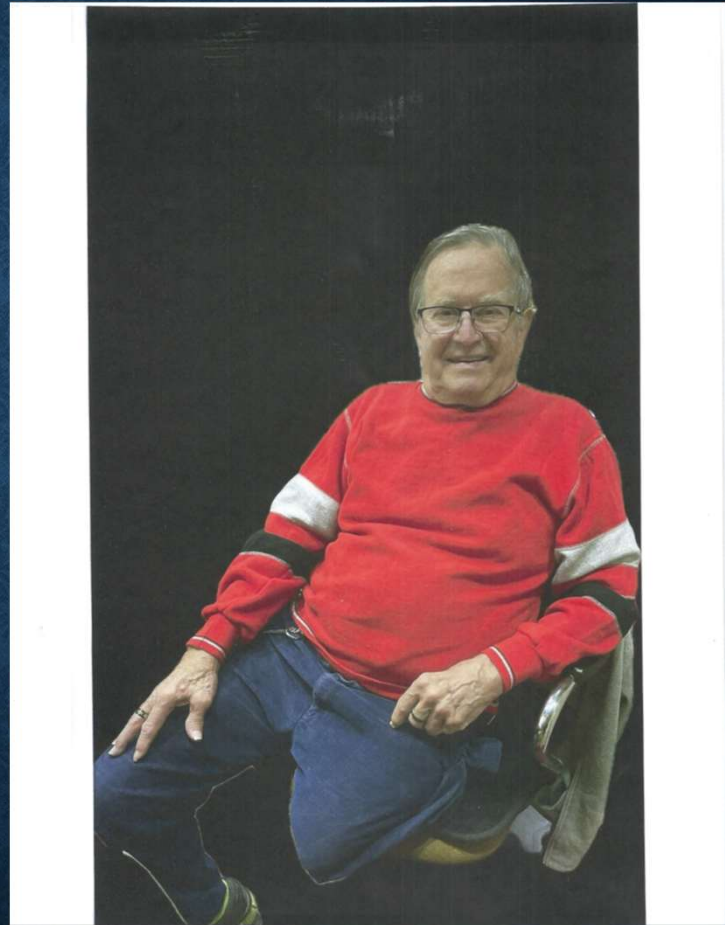

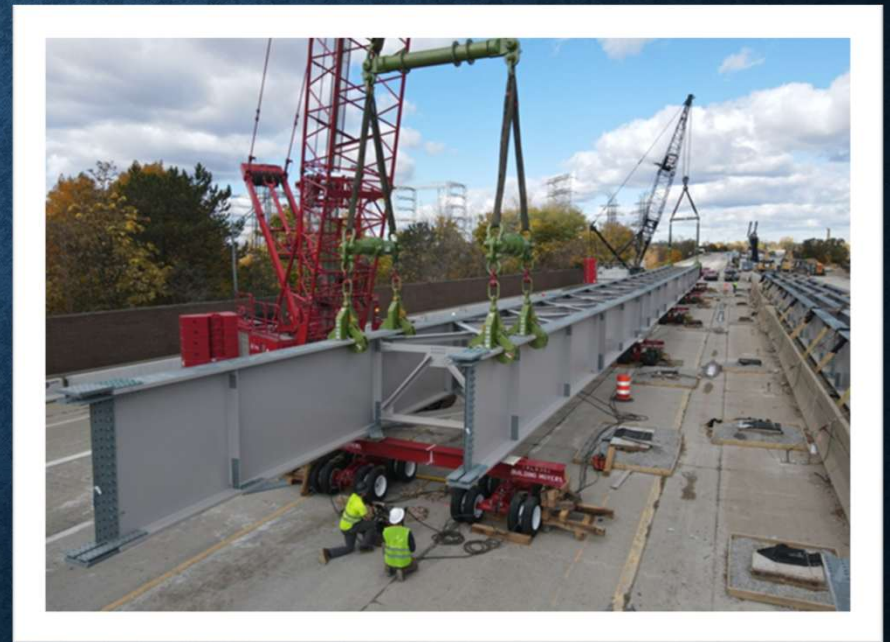

# MOST UNUSUAL MOVE

## Talaski Building Movers

Talaski was contracted to move six 277 foot bridge beam as part of I-475 Road Rebuilding Project. The first two beams were moved as a pair with a total length of 328 feet and a weight of 386,000 pounds. The last four beams were moved separately. The job was completed in four days with a crew of 4 guys, 10 dollies, and their Peterbuilt truck.









# HISTORIC AWARD

Morrows House Moving & Scribs Moving

Moving the Skylon Ballroom a 72' X 115' arched building. This unusual structure was built using 1" X 4" boards that were bowed around a series of posts and layered to form the arches, 5 to 8 layers thick. The very large arches were then stood up in place and sheathed with 1" X 8" shiplap lumber and shingled.











# TALLEST STRUCTURE MOVED

Thein Structural Moving

Thein Structural Moving relocated this grain bin 2 blocks.  
It is 90 feet in diameter, weighs 300 ton, and is 115 feet tall.





# WIDEST STRUCTURE MOVED

Macus Building Movers

This Turkey Barn was moved by Vest MN. The Building was 160' long and 80' wide. Marcus used power dollies to complete the project.







# WIDEST HOUSE MOVED

## Ferneau House Moving

They moved this house near Huxley Iowa in June of 2024. The house was 30 feet high, 75' long, and 54 feet wide.







# LONGEST STRUCTURE MOVED

DeVooght House & Building Movers

DeVooght relocated the Grandstand at the Wisconsin State Fairground at Stoughton WI. They moved and rotated the Grandstand, to align with the new master plan for the fairgrounds. The Grandstand was 24 feet high, 40 feet wide, and 160 feet long.





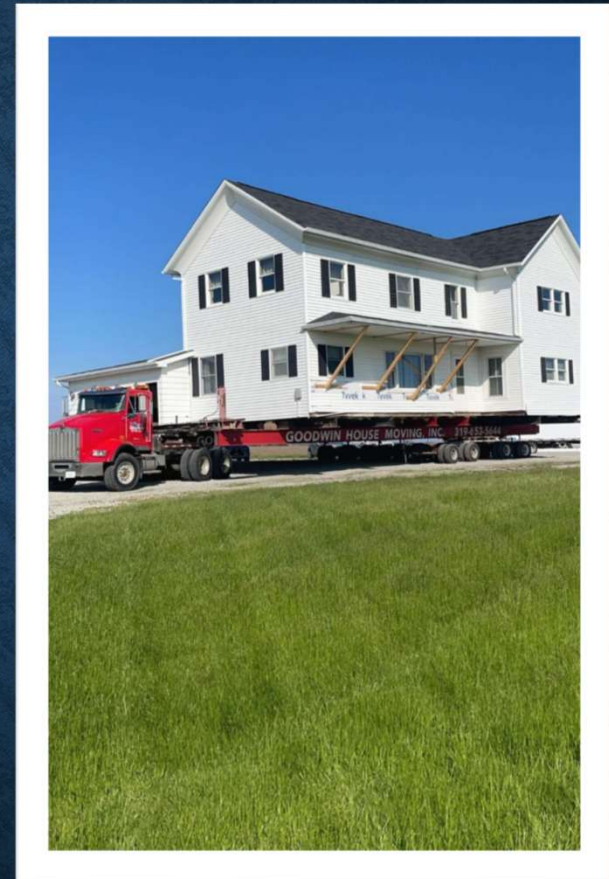




# LONGEST HOUSE MOVED

# HEAVIEST WOODEN STRUCTURE MOVED

Anderson Building Movers

A two story plus addition house was moved off a farmsite so the the owners could build a new patio home. They spent over \$100K and seven years remodeling this house, so we were happy to be able to save it. The house was 35 feet high, 28 feet wide and 48 feet long. It weighed 230,000 pounds.





# HEAVIEST MASONRY STRUCTURE MOVED

390 tons, moved in Madison WI. Measured 51  
feet high, 30 feet wide, and 84 feet long. This  
was the heaviest building ever moved in  
Madison WI.







# LARGEST STRUCTURE BY SQUARE FOOTAGE ON ONE FLOOR MOVED

Jepson Structural

This was an interesting job located in St. Cloud Minnesota. This structure (roof) had been lifted by a specialty roof lifting contractor from 20 feet up to 40' much of the new structural steel had been installed when several engineering errors were discovered. Every option was explored and ultimately the bank that was over seeing the project decided it was best to lower the roof back down to it original position. The roof was 124 feet by 180 feet and weighed 290 tons. It took crews from Jepson, Anderson, Goldschmidt, and DeVooght 2 days to jack the roof down 20 feet.

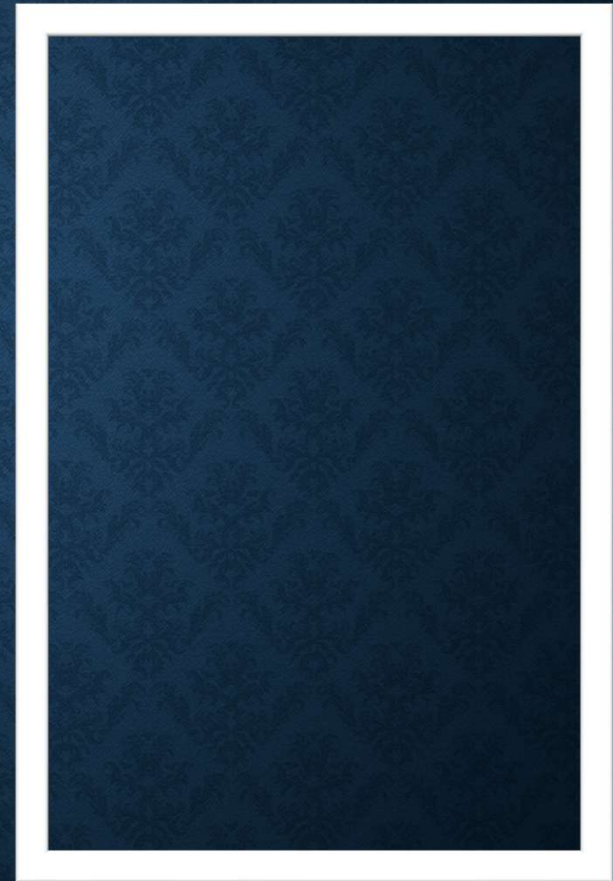




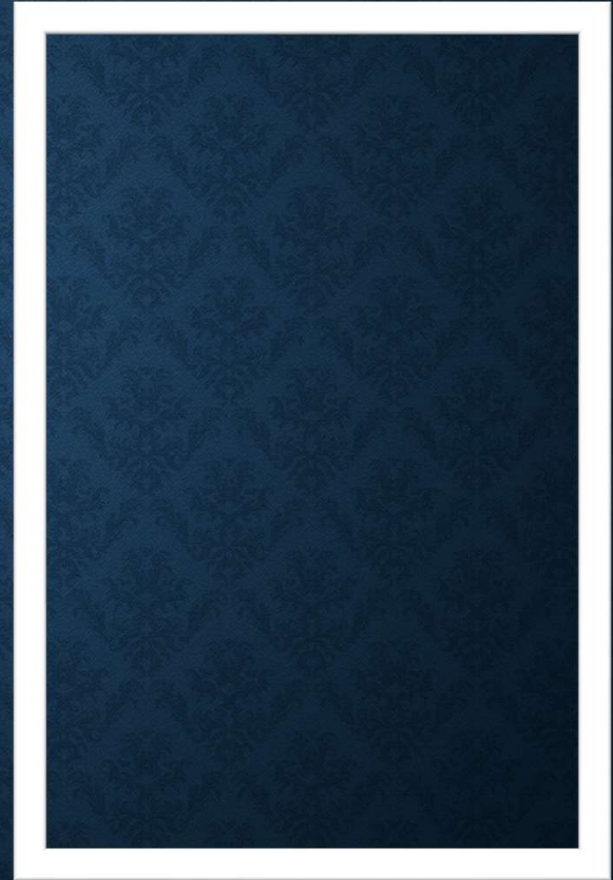
